SUCCESS CRITERIA - Schools wishing to be awarded with the Active School Flag must be able to say 'yes' to and demonstrate evidence of the following:

Success Criteria – PARTNERSHIPS
Our school website/blog includes an ASF section about Partnerships
Our school has emailed the Local Sports Partnership to let them know that we are working towards/renewing the ASF
Our school has emailed the HSE Health Promotion Officer for the area to let them know that we are working towards/renewing the ASF
Our school established an ASF committee at the outset of the process
The pupil members of the ASF committee have been given leadership roles
Our school has an ASF notice board and suggestions box
Our school acknowledges physical activity and sports achievements achieved during and outside of school hours
Our school informs pupils and parents about physical activity opportunities that are available in the local community
Senior pupils conducted a 'What Club Are You In?' survey to find out about physical activity opportunities in the local community
Our school has invited different sports clubs/physical activity providers from the local community to visit our school for ASW, or at other times this year, to give taster sessions of their activity. New activities are introduced each year.
Our school has sought advice and support to ensure that children with special needs can avail of all PE and physical activity opportunities
RENEWAL - Our school surveyed Pupils in relation to PE, physical activity and the ASF process and acted upon the feedback
RENEWAL - Our school surveyed Parents in relation to PE, physical activity and the ASF process and acted upon the feedback
