



School Website

The screening committee will view your school website/PPT alongside your application form.

Your website/PPT must provide evidence that your school is fulfilling all of the ASF success criteria.

It is important that captions accompany photos and that the content is organised under four headings:

1. Physical Education
2. Physical Activity
3. Partnerships
4. Active School Week



Physical Education

The PHYSICAL EDUCATION section of your website/ PowerPoint must provide the following evidence:

1. Confirmation that all classes receive one hour timetabled PE every week.
2. Confirmation that all classes are taught at least five different PE strands each year.
3. Explanation/visual evidence of the work undertaken in the priority PE strand area.



Physical Activity

The PHYSICAL ACTIVITY section of your website/ PowerPoint must provide the following evidence:

1. Confirmation that children receive two outdoor breaks per day
2. Confirmation of the *Do Your Talking as You're Walking* policy
3. Playground Leaders — Playground Equipment
4. Active breaks in the classroom/Rainy day breaks
5. Active calendar events — Halloween/Christmas/Easter events
6. Active Lines (renewal schools)



Partnerships

The PARTNERSHIPS section of your website/
PowerPoint must provide the following evidence:

1. ASF committee
2. *What Clubs are You In?* survey
3. School – Community links
4. National programmes (if applicable)



Active School Week

The ACTIVE SCHOOL WEEK section of your website/ PowerPoint must provide the following evidence:

1. ASW Programme
2. Explanation/visual evidence of the events of ASW
3. Physical activity as homework
4. Whole school FUN events
5. Taster sessions of NEW activities
