Dingbats are visual word puzzles from which a well known phrase, saying or word has to be identified.

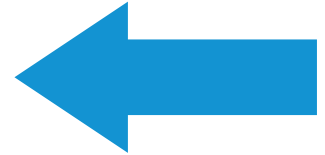
Follow the route to complete more dingbats. Some are more tricky than others!

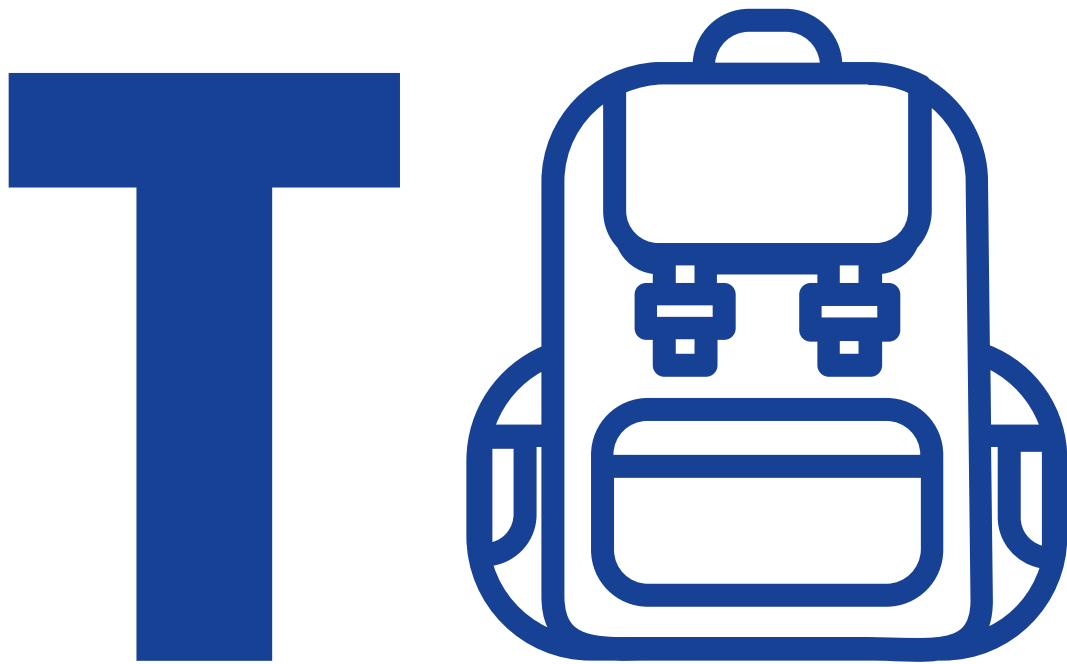
